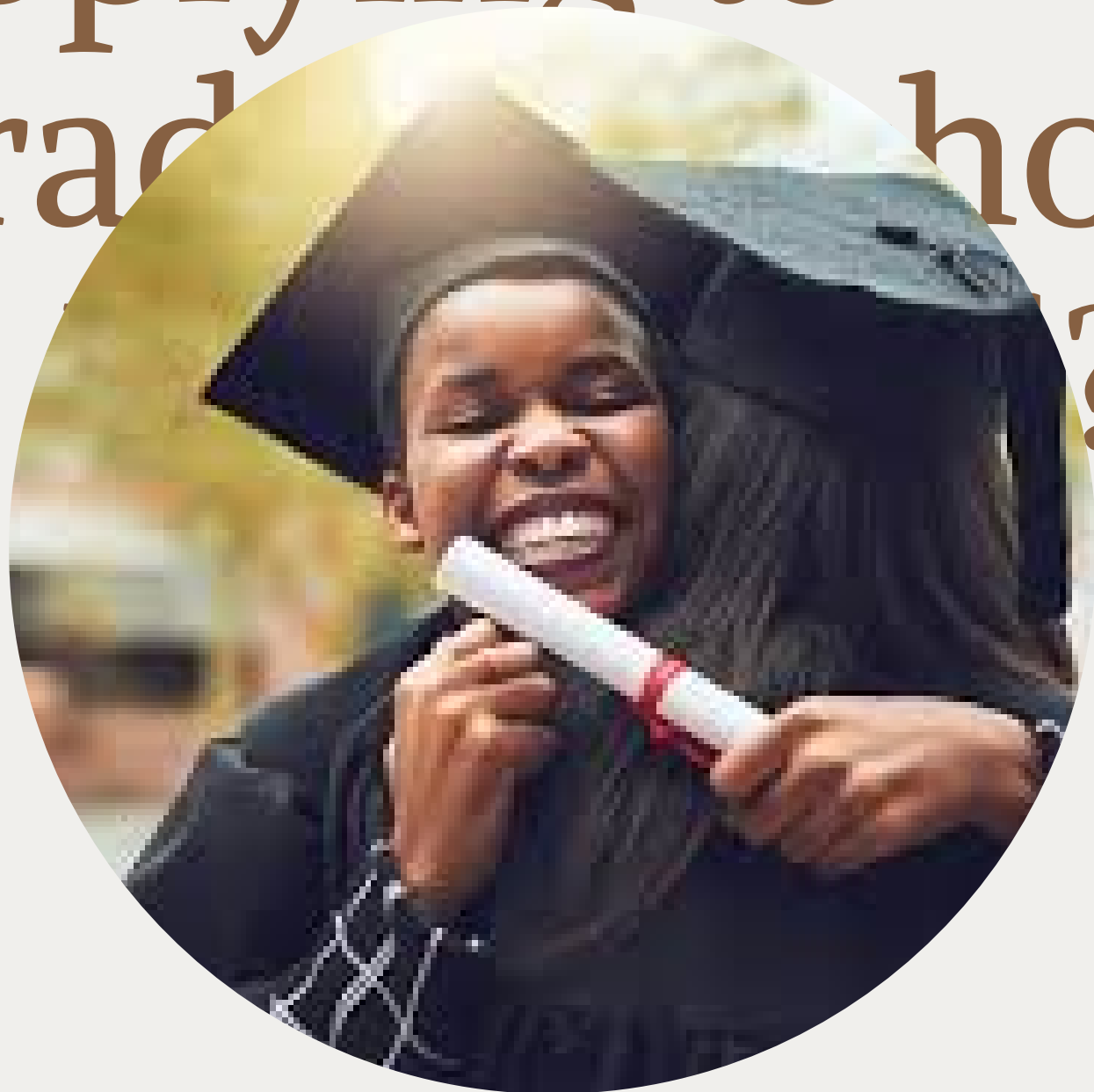


# Not Sure About Graduate School?
